## Lottery Form for School Year 2025/26

**Lottery Process.** Thank you for your interest in Crete Academy. In accordance with Crete Academy's lottery policies, if the number of children interested in a specific grade exceeds the number of seats available for that grade, names will be drawn through a random automated lottery process. Furthermore, if the number of lottery forms for a specific grade is fewer than the seats we have available all children with completed forms are automatically admitted.

**Priority Preference.** Priority preference is determined in the following order:

- Students with siblings of currently enrolled at Charter School who reside within the LAUSD boundaries
- Students whose families provided volunteer help in establishing the school (founding families) who reside within LAUSD boundaries (not to exceed 10% of enrollment)
- Children of Crete employees who reside within the LAUSD boundaries (not to exceed 10% of enrollment)
- All other students who reside within the LAUSD district
- Students with siblings of currently enrolled at the charter school who do not reside within the LAUSD boundaries
- Students whose families provided volunteer help in establishing the school (founding families) who do not reside within the LAUSD boundaries (not to exceed 10% of enrollment)
- Children of Crete employees who do not reside within the LAUSD boundaries (not to exceed 10% of enrollment)
- All other students who do not reside within the LAUSD boundaries

Please specify if the child fits into one or more of these categories. Falsification of this information will result in your child losing priority in the lottery.

Charter School shall not require a parent/legal guardian/student to provide information regarding a student's disability, gender, gender identity, gender expression, nationality, legal or economic status, primary language or English Learner status, race or ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or any other characteristic that is contained in the definition of hate





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crimes set forth in section 422.55 of the Penal Code, or any other information that would violate federal or state law, prior to admission, participation in any admissions or attendance lottery, or pre-enrollment event or process, or as a condition of admission or enrollment. Charter School may request, at the time of, and as part of, conducting its lottery process, the provision of information necessary to apply specific admissions preferences set forth in this Charter. Charter School shall not request or require submission of a student's IEP, 504 Plan, or any other record or related information prior to admission, participation in any admissions or attendance lottery, or pre-enrollment event or process, or as a condition of admission or enrollment.
